



#### Threaded Herringbone

To make the block of Threaded Herringbone, first work legs 1 - 24 in 1 ply 931A, Light Mauve. Then, using 1 ply 931A, Very Light Mauve, thread these legs as shown in stitch diagram below, bringing needle up at point A, threading under and over the herringbones across the band, and then back down at point B. Work another three horizontal rows of Threaded Herringbone to finish the block.




# Three Sided Stitch

Three-sided Stitch is a pulled thread stitch so each leg should be worked twice and pulled tightly to create the open, airy look of the stitch. Using 1 strand Soie 100/3 in 080, Cream work legs 1 - 19 as shown in stitch diagram at right. Remember to work each leg twice. Then work the row beneath (legs 20 - 38). Repeat these two rows to complete the block of Three-sided Stitch. Note that the bottom horizontal legs of the upper row will always share a space with the upper horizontal legs of the row beneath it.




#### Triple Rice Stitch

Using 1 ply 693, Light Gold, first work legs A - D of the Triple Rice Stitch flowers as shown at right. Then, using 1 ply 321, Light Blue, work legs 1 - 24 to complete the stitch. Work three more Triple Rice Stitches to complete the band.




## Tete de Boeuf

Using 1 ply 693, Light Gold, first work legs 1 - 4 (a small lazy daisy) of the Tete de Boeuf as shown at right. Then, using 1 ply 348, Dark Olive, work legs 5 - 8. Make two more Tete de Boeufs to complete the band.




## Thorn Stitch


To make the Thorn Stitch tree, first work the trunk as a row of back stitches as shown in the stitch diagram at right in gray in 1 ply 982, Taupe. Then using 1 ply 348, Dark Olive, begin to fill the tree with Thorn Stitches as shown at right. First work an Upright Thorn stitch (legs A - D). Then work legs 1 - 32 and continue in this manner until all the branches of the tree are completed.



# Trellis Couching


Using 1 strand of Soie Perlee in 080, Cream, first fill the band with vertical straight stitches (legs A - H). Then work horizontal straight stitches across them (legs I - L). Then make diagonal stitches across this grid (legs 1 - 21). When this ground is completed, couch the vertical, horizontal and diagonal stitches where all three meet by working a half cross stitch (legs AA - BB) in 1 ply Light Olive.






## Upright Rice Stitch

To make the block of Upright Rice and Upright Crosses as shown on the master chart, work the Upright Rice stitches first as shown in the stitch diagram at right using 1 ply 931A, Very Light Mauve.




# Upright Cross Stitch

After making all of the Upright Rice stitches, complete the block by working Upright Crosses between them using 1 ply 934, Dark Mauve, following stitch diagram at right.




# Up and Down Buttonhole

Using 1 strand Soie Perlee in 080, Cream, work a band of Up and Down Buttonhole where indicated on the master chart as shown in stitch diagram at right



## Underline Stitch

Using 1 ply 348, Dark Olive, make a band of Underline stitches where indicated on the master chart following stitch diagram at right. Work another row directly beneath it using 1 ply 342, Light Olive. Repeat these two rows to fill the block with Underline stitches.



# Umbrella Charm

Using 1 ply 321, Light Blue, work a background of half cross stitch rain drops where indicated on the master chart. Then sew on the Umbrella Charm in the center of this block using 1 strand of Soie 100/3 in 080, Cream.
