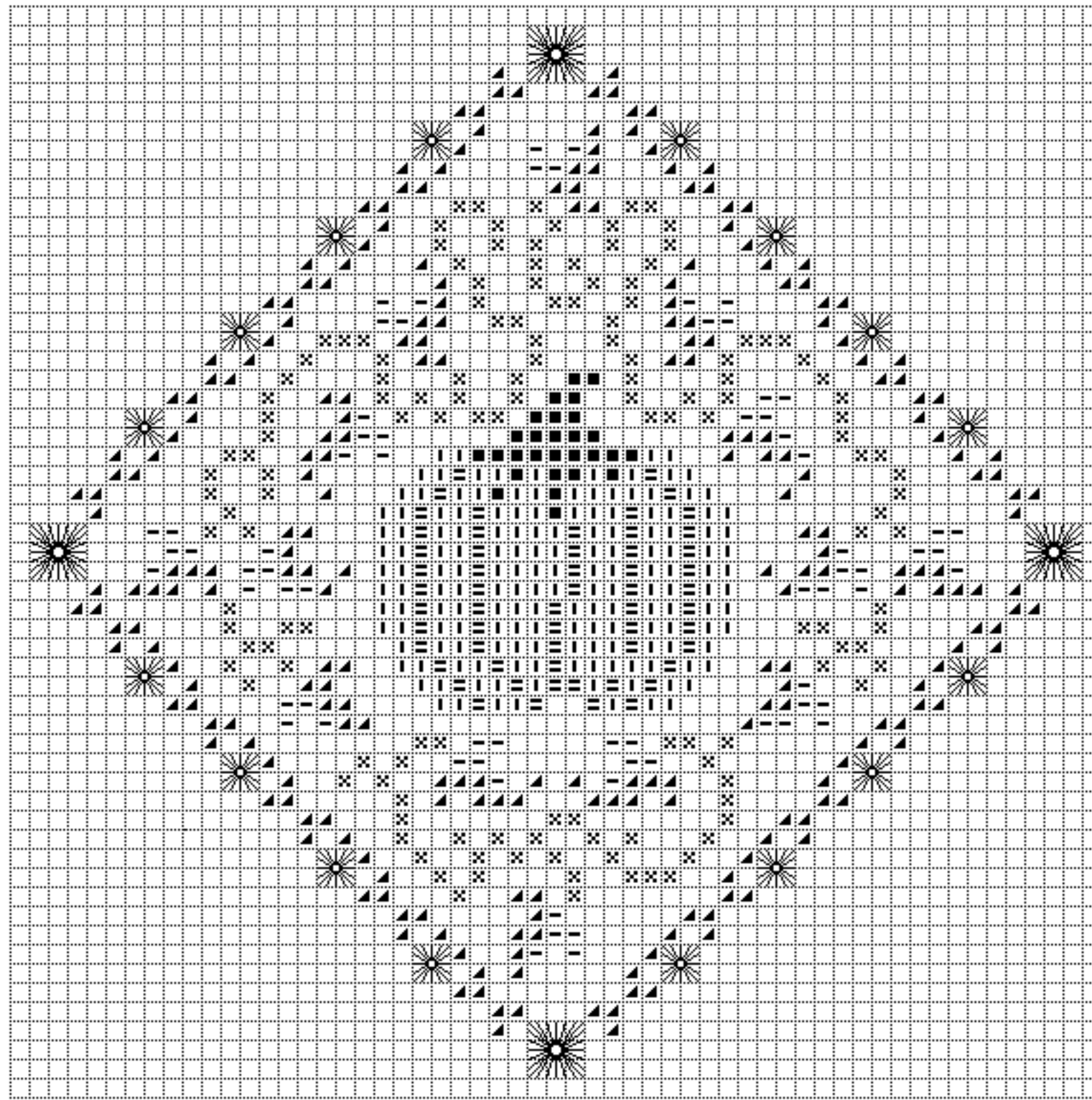

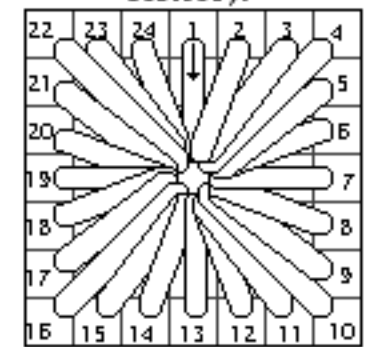

Edinburgh Linen

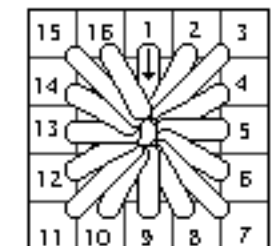
DMC Embroidery floss in:
610 - Brown Dark
611 - Brown Medium
676 - Yellow
781 - Pumpkin Dark
783 - Pumpkin Medium
3051 - Green Dark
3052 - Green Medium

DIRECTIONS:

Stitch on 36 count linen over
two threads of fabric using
1 strand of floss. Follow
stitch diagrams below to make
Eyelet Stitches (work each leg
from the outside into the
center).



Eyelet over 6 threads



Eyelet over 4 threads

FINISHING:

Step 1:

Count out 24 threads from each of the four points of the design area.
Score and cut away excess fabric.

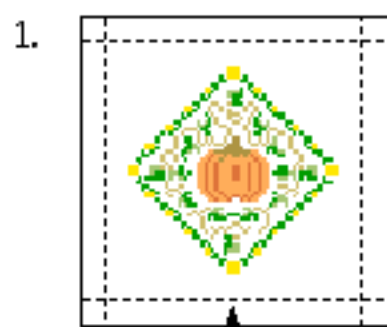
Step 2:

Fold the keep in half horizontally (right sides together) and stitch across
each side 10 threads in from the cut edge. Turn keep right side out. Fold
under 10 threads along unfinished edge (toward inside).

Step 3:

Make two twisted cords from DMC 3051 (or use purchased ribbon). Fold
each in half and knot at ends. Insert knotted end of one cord into opening
at top of keep and begin to whip stitch opening together. Leave a small

area unstitched at the center of the keep. Insert
knotted end of other cord into bottom of keep and
whip stitch toward center opening. Fill keep with rice
through opening. After filling, finish whip stitching
the opening together. Loop one cord through
scissors and the other through loop of needlecase or
other accessory.
